EXTINGUISHING THE THIRD CANDLE

A LITANY FOR LENT (responsively) based on Psalm 32

One: Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven, whose wrongs are pardoned.

All: Happy is the one whom the Lord does not accuse of doing wrong and who is free of all deceit.

One: While I kept silence, my body wasted away through my groaning all day long, for night and day your hand was heavy upon me.

All: Then I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not hide my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," and you forgave the guilt of my sin.

One: Therefore, let all who are faithful offer prayer to you; at a time of distress, the rush of mighty waters shall not reach them.

All: You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with glad cries of deliverance.

One: God says, "I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you.

All: Many are the torments of the wicked, but steadfast love surrounds those who trust in the Lord.
