STATEMENT OF OUR CORE VALUES:

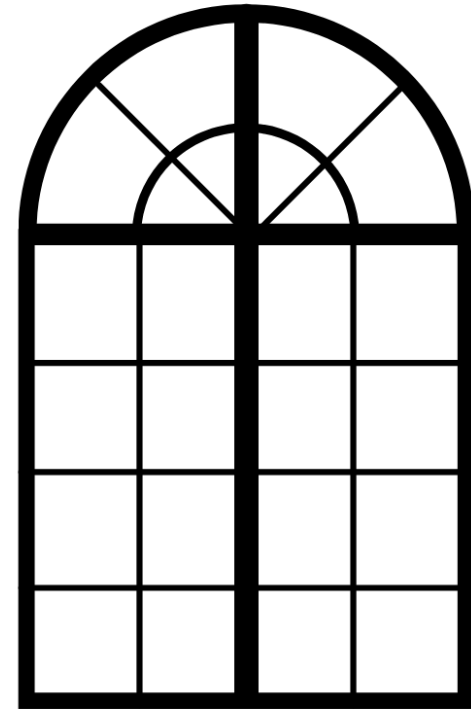
In order to fulfill our mission, it is essential that we have:
